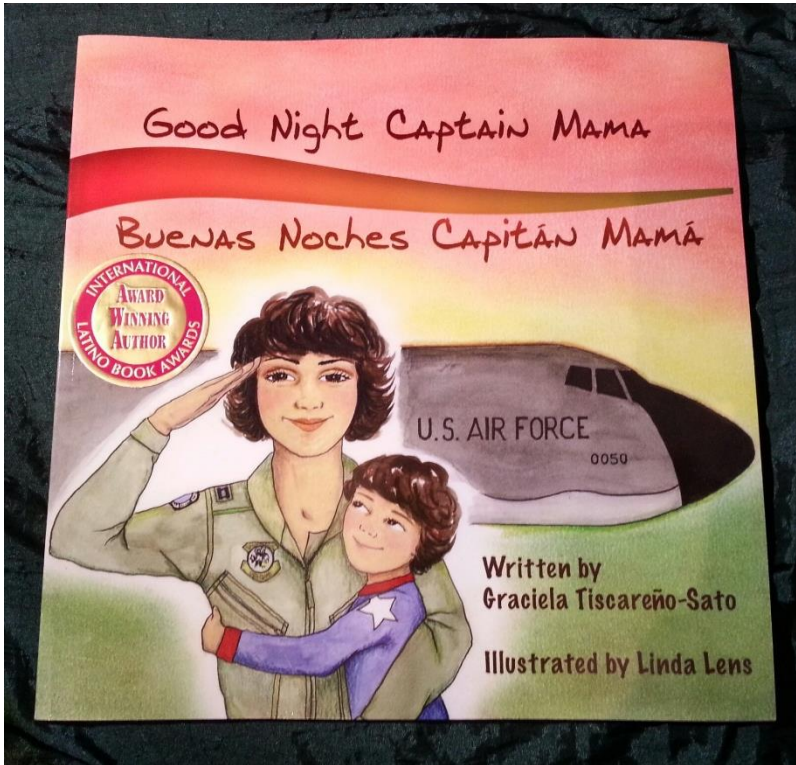

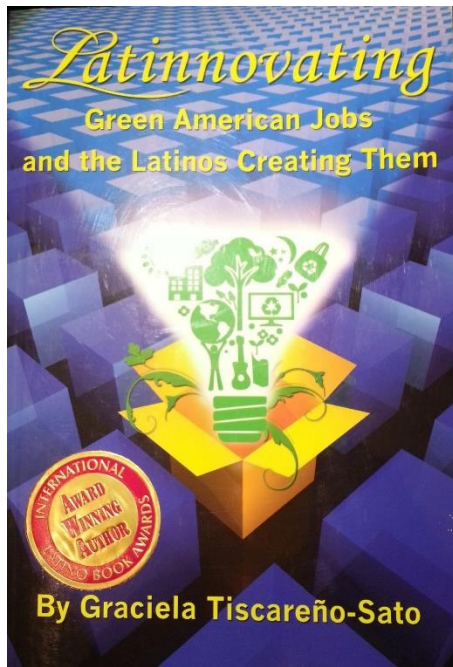
Book Awards won in 2014 for *Good Night Captain Mama/ Buenas Noches Capitán Mamá*:

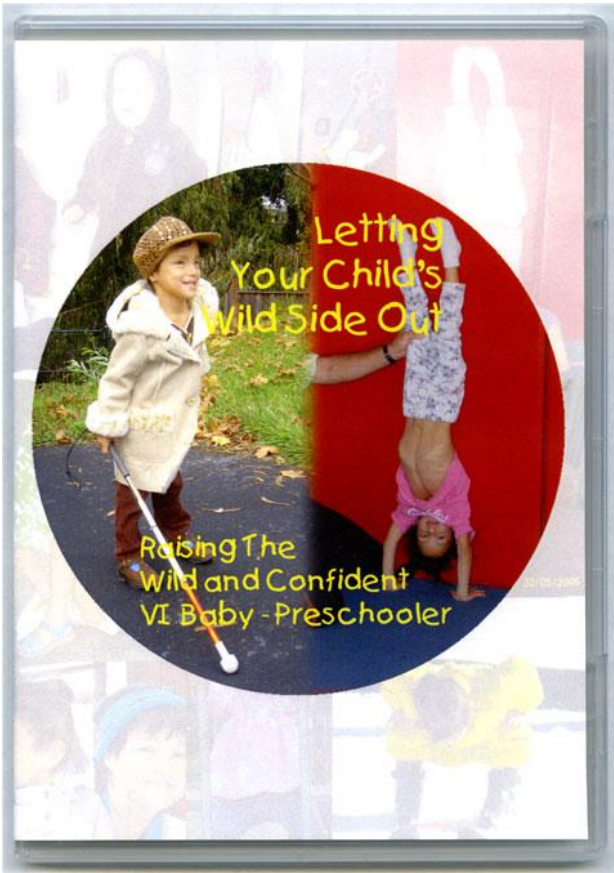

Do you want to spread the message to families to not overprotect their child who doesn't see? Do you run into resistance when you try? Would you like some help in starting that important conversation?

Are you looking for a unique new way to share stories and suggest recreational activities to families with kids who are visually-impaired?

As the parents of a kindergartener who is blind, we created this unique multimedia DVD to help. We hope this content will inspire you.

It's a five-year case study on how we embraced early intervention services, applied them, and laid the foundation for our daughter who is now a downhill skier, trapeze artist and gymnast. The DVD is full of photos and videos of our child in action.

Families will benefit greatly by hearing about our experiences. We show activities we made available to our daughter, from birth to age five. In 30 minutes, you'll see our child grow from baby to downhill skier, gaining a strong sense of self-confidence and eagerness to learn at every stage.

We hope this DVD will motivate the families you serve by providing specific ideas of what they can do now (and in the future) with their small child. Most importantly, you'll see the results: a truly confident, creative and capable little girl.
